

## Student Learning Outcome Policy

### Rationale

Wilandra Rise will embed a culture of curriculum planning and assessment that impacts on learning programs, and will adjust them to suit individual student needs so that students reach their full potential. Wilandra Rise will strengthen the use of student assessment data and feedback to evaluate students' progress, monitor the impact of teaching and adjust learning programs and interventions.

### Implementation

The important focus is to use data to inform teaching as well as to collect data for summative and reporting purposes.

We will do this by:

- Developing a Strategic Plan that outlines targets and goals to be achieved across the life of the plan, based on the data sets available
- The Annual Implementation Plan will detail the yearly plan in progress, to teach to and meet the set targets
- Term and weekly planners will be developed to specifically reflect team teaching to support the goals and targets set out in the Strategic Plan and Annual Implementation Plan
- Learning Communities will be given Professional Learning Time on a weekly basis to reflect on the relationship between data collection sets and the actions they need to take in their teaching plans  
Eg. Use pre-test data to inform teaching strategy
- Use post test data to assess student progress and provide feedback to students
- Teaching teams will discuss and adapt their programs based on evidence
- Students not meeting identified targets and/or those exceeding targets will have individual learning plans.

### Assessment & Reporting

Aggregated data available via the School Portal will be shared with the school community through the Annual Report and discussed, when relevant, with School Council. Examples of this aggregated data will be NAPLAN, Victorian Curriculum Teacher Judgments (Literacy and Numeracy), Teacher and Parent Opinion Surveys, Attitude to School Survey, Attendance Outcomes, and Financial Statements.
